Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class." No Tape on Ears.

Junior - 12 Mos. & Under 15 Mos.

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

5. Concession stand will be open Friday from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. during Friday move-in. Open 7:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday.
6. For all emergencies, call 911. Telephones are available at the show site for this purpose.
7. You may now enter this show on line using PayPal. To submit your on-line entry(ies), go to www.BleakneyShowServices.com and click on "Enter A Show". Just follow the directions on that page. There is also a blank AKC entry form for your use on the same page. If you do not have a PayPal account, it is easy to set one up. Just go to www.PayPal.com, click on "Sign Up" and follow the directions. There are no sign-up fees.
8. A recording fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. These Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
9. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money order in U.S. funds.
10. Baby strollers are not allowed in the building.
11. Unentered dogs are not allowed in the building.
12. No food may be brought into the building that is not prepared by the concessionaire. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the building.
13. RV parking with electrical hookups is available for \$15.00 per night on a first-come basis.
14. **RV Parking - No generators may be operated in the electrical hookup area.**
15. **RV fees collected by HCCC manager. All Rental Fees for HCCC facility (RV hookups and stalls) are per calendar day beginning 12:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.**
16. NO exhibitors will be permitted on the show grounds before 8:00 a.m., Friday, February 18, 2011.
17. Rings will be on a packed, rolled dirt surface. Enclosed building is not heated. Electrical outlets are available on a first-come basis.
18. No personal heaters.
19. No generators may be operated within 50 feet of the building.
20. No chairs provided.
21. Bring your own extra lighting and extension cords.
22. Bathing dogs in DESIGNATED area only
23. No exercise pens allowed in building except in Reserved Grooming or Rented Stalls. No mats, rugs, roping off, **soft-sided crates**, ex pens or saving of space in free grooming area. **No crating or grooming on arena floor. All dog crates must have an ID and phone number on them in order to contact owner in case of an emergency.**
24. Rabies certificates are required. Tags do not constitute proof.
25. Holding crates will be allowed 20 minutes before scheduled judging and must be removed immediately following Best of Breed.
26. Please keep your area clean, bring a broom!
27. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.
28. All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stole, and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.
29. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
30. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
31. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Clubs nor their Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

32. Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging.
33. The show-giving clubs, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
34. Puppies under the age of six months are strictly prohibited from entry into the show site.
35. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children while attending these shows.
36. The clubs reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
37. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.
38. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
39. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
40. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
41. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.
42. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
43. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
